RESPONSE TO COURT'S 9/21/22 ORDER**

COMES NOW Defendant David Eastman (“Representative Eastman” or “Mr. Eastman”), by and through the Law Offices of Joseph Miller, LLC, and hereby provides this Response to the Court’s 9/21/22 Order regarding “whether it would be feasible for the Division to delay certifying the results from House District 27 until after trial in this case without impacting certification of the other results of the general election.” The answer to whether the Division could *practically* accomplish this is squarely within the control of the State. However, even if it were possible, Representative Eastman contends that an order delaying certification of *only* his race, statewide, is not *feasible* as it would likely affect voter perceptions and improperly influence House District 27’s ongoing election.
